## Purbeck Instrument Loan Scheme

The Purbeck Instrument Loan Scheme is a section of the Isle of Purbeck Arts Club Charity. Its purpose is to lend orchestral instruments to students aged 18 and under in full time education, living or being educated in the Swanage and Wareham area.

To take advantage of the scheme, you need to:

- 1. Make an annual payment (currently of £20) to "Purbeck Instrument Loan Scheme", which includes Junior Membership of the Arts Club.
- Complete an Application Form, confirming that your child is or will be receiving lessons, and a signed copy of the Terms and Conditions. (Under the Terms and Conditions, a student must be receiving lessons in order to borrow an instrument.)
- 3. Return both of these to your school music teacher in Swanage or to Mrs Jay Buckle, 9 Bon Accord Road, Swanage, Dorset, BH19 2DN.

Some financial assistance may be available as specified below:

- 1) 20 grants of £100 towards tuition fees, payable in 3 termly instalments of £30 plus a £10 Music voucher for those learning the following instruments: oboe, bassoon, viola, cello, double bass, horn, trombone, euphonium. Not to exceed the total cost of lessons.
- 2) Any PILS member taking an ABRSM or Trinity Guildhall exam Grade 3 or above, can apply for a grant to cover the cost of their exam fee.
- 3) Family membership fee: £20 for the first child and only an additional £3 Arts Club Junior Membership fee for subsequent siblings.
- 4) A PILS member may apply for a second instrument at no further charge as long as they are having tuition on the second instrument.

Family membership will be automatically applied. Please apply by email or letter to Jay Buckle for any of the other available grants. All grants are at the discretion of the committee.
